# **Convergence Insufficiency**

## **Common symptoms:**

**eyestrain, headaches, blurred vision, double vision, inability to concentrate, short attention span, frequent loss of place, squinting, rubbing, closing or covering an eye, sleepiness during the activity, trouble remembering what was read, words appear to move, jump, swim or float, and problems with motion sickness and/or vertigo.**

# Suppression

**The brain will ignore the weaker eye causing:**

**Misjudgment with distances or with where things really are**

**They will seem clumsy**

**They will trip, spill things, bump into furniture or other objects, and have mishaps with parking the car.**
